SDCERA's pension fund, with \$8.4 billion in assets at June 30, 2012, has in recent years outperformed 95% of its public fund peers with assets over \$1 billion, as reported by the Trust Universe Comparison Service (TUCS). The pension fund's performance was in the top 5% for the most recent 1-, 2-, and 3-year periods with a portfolio that has lower-than-median risk.
